Mould and mildew are easily removed, leaving no visible damage as may occur with other materials.

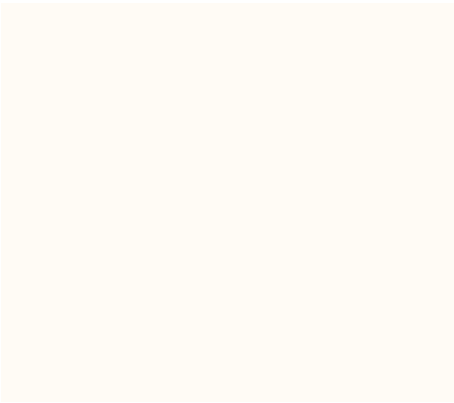
When Corian® looks clean, it really is clean.
